- o Participants who have completed previous Treks may be considered reserves and are encouraged to apply for roles such as facilitator, POC, or admin support if interested.
- o Trojan's Trek programs are planned, organised, and conducted by individuals who have served in the ADF, Police Force, First Responders, and, Corrections.
